Under the new legislation, from April 2025 **every** Personal Assistant will have to be part of the PVG (Protecting Vulnerable Groups) scheme.

The Protecting Vulnerable Groups (PVG) scheme helps ensure people who are unsuitable to work with children, young adults and adults cannot do regulated work with them.
